

Marilla Sno-Mob James Stevenson Sr. Memorial Scholarship

2025 Scholarship Rules and Information

Applications are currently being accepted for two (2) \$500 scholarships in memory of James Stevenson Sr. Only students who are members or their parents who are members in good standing of the Marilla Sno-Mob Snowmobile Club and the New York State Snowmobile Association (NYSSA) as of January 1, 2025 will be eligible for consideration.

Criterion: The Marilla Sno-Mob Scholarship Committee will review all applications and make its award based upon academic achievement, active involvement in the Marilla Sno-Mob and the quality of the original essay submitted with each application.

- Applicants must be graduating high school seniors who have been accepted at a college, junior college, or vocational school.
- The student's parent(s) or guardian(s), or the student if over 18, must be a member in good standing of Marilla Sno-Mob Snowmobile Club and the New York State Snowmobile Association (NYSSA) as of January 1, 2025. - Applicants must have actively participated in some aspect(s) of club operations for the Marilla Sno-Mob during the 2024-2025 snowmobile season and have at least sixteen (16) documented volunteer hours to substantiate this. The enclosed *Volunteer Hours form* must be completed and submitted with the application for consideration. Participation in club operations could include trail maintenance, trail marking, assisting with club-sponsored events (i.e. Safety Course, canned food drive, etc.), or other work necessary to run the organization.
- Completed application form and all required attachments (described below) must be received by the Marilla Sno-Mob by **May 15, 2025** as **one package.** All applications must be complete to be considered.
- Late applications will not be considered!
- The applications submitted to the Marilla Sno-Mob will be answered by mail after judging.
- The selected applicant will be notified by the Marilla Sno-Mob President.
- Marilla Sno-Mob reserves the right to publish essays in full or part along with applicant's photo for the promotion of snowmobiling in any of our publications or on our website and social media. By signing and submitting the scholarship application, the scholarship applicant agrees to these terms.

All application materials are considered confidential and will be limited to examination for their intended purpose only and become property of the Marilla Sno-Mob Snowmobile Club.
